1. Welcome Back: Theme this year **FRESH START**
2. Kitchen Changes: we had explored other options over the winter, sublet the kitchen to private contractor/caterer (not successful for this year), so next choice was to reduce menu options, Keep it simple
 - New reality: extremely restricted access, take out or prepackaged options only, we are exploring alternatives such as temporary placement of vending machines for sandwiches, snacks, cold drinks
3. Pro Shop: NO new orders have been placed for this year
 - Access to the clothing is not available until restrictions have been lifted, then watch for liquidation sale to reduce inventory
 - Would like to see a display case to display the old clubs donated and bring old trophies out of storage (some of you talented crafts people may be able to do this?)
 - Do we have records of how long people have been members? Opportunity to recognize long term (20+), we could put pictures on the wall, create our own "Hall of Fame"
4. Prizes for Tournaments will require some innovative thinking this year – think outside of the box. Most prizes are donated, so if you have received something that you don't want or can't use, donate it back, reuse and recycle)
 - Step up and don't be afraid to ask employers or former employers to support your club (we understand it will be more difficult than ever this year, but if you don't ask, you won't know what they might say).
5. Themes for Mixed Socials (these are a few ideas I dreamed up over the winter, feel free to offer other ideas)
 - a. Welcome Back – Happy New Years Party (noisemakers, party hats)
 - b. Canada Day
 - c. Christmas in July – (Chinese gift exchange, Christmas sweaters, decorated golf carts)
 - d. Happy Unbirthday Party – another chance to regift that prize you won last year, Birthday cake
 - e. Thanksgiving – give thanks for what we have and for each other
 - f. Happy Anniversary to BG&CC – designed in 1906 as per the internet search, opened in 1912, 2022 will be 110 years old
 - g. Box Social Lunch and golf partners for an afternoon round (Saturday or Sunday afternoon, share picnic lunch and then golf partners for 9 holes?)
6. Anyone interested in putting together a float (or decorated golf carts) for the Bashaw days parade? Thank the town for their support of our club.
7. Revive some of the ways to get to know each other better – potluck supper to welcome new members and new into the campground – again, table for later after things settle back to some sense of normal or just add to the list for next year?
